

PRIVACY POLICY W.R.T. THE WEBSITE AND CONTACTING US BY E-MAIL

By surfing to our website (www.heroesforzero.be), subscribing to our newsletter or contacting us (through the contact form or by sending us an e-mail) you provide us certain personal data and you consent that we, Heroes for Zero , with registered address at Auguste Snieders 36, 1030 Schaarbeek and registered in the CBE under number 0741.551.043 (hereinafter “we”, “us”, “our”), shall process these personal data in the context of your use of the website.

It primarily concerns the following personal data: your full name, e-mail address, postal code.

Where you provide us with personal data of someone else you guarantee that this personal data is collected in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulation (Reg. 2016/679, “GDPR”).

We will process your personal data to answer your request when you contact us through the contact form (article 6.1. (a) (consent) GDPR); to provide you with our newsletter when you subscribe (recital (47) and article 6.1. (f) (legitimate interest) GDPR and article XII.13 Belgian Code of Economic Law); for statistical purposes regarding the use of our website (article 6.1. (f) GDPR).

To the extent necessary to carry-out the aforementioned purposes, and depending on (the nature of) your request, we can share your personal data with third parties such as suppliers (e.g. IT service provider, suppliers in the context of marketing), etc. If these recipients process your personal data outside of the European Economic Area, we will use our best efforts to conclude the necessary (contractual) safeguards in this regard (e.g. EC Standard Clauses or similar contractual safeguards), where required.

When legally justified or required, the personal data may also be transferred to competent governments and/or other law enforcement authorities (e.g. police, investigating judge, national data protection authority, etc.).

You have the right to access and rectify your personal data in the event they are incorrect or incomplete, as well as the right to erasure and the right to object and the right to restriction of the processing under the conditions set out in the applicable legislation. In as far the processing is based on your consent, you may withdraw your consent at all times. In such event it might be impossible for us (as the case may be, the other recipients) to perform our (contractual) obligations vis-à-vis you. We (and as the case may be, the other recipients) do not accept any responsibility in this regard.

You have the right to obtain a copy (in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format) of your personal data and the right to have your personal data transmitted to another controller (‘data portability’).

If you have a question or complaint, we ask you to contact us directly. We will retain your personal data. Please note that e-mails/documents containing your personal data may be retained longer should this be required by law (e.g. for accountancy or archiving purposes).
